

Off street – car parks – parking appeals policy

Please refer to the table below that explains the contravention code and indicates circumstances where cancellation will be considered, it is important to note that this information is for guidance and that each case will be considered on its individual merits.

Circumstances in which the cancellation of a Penalty Charge Notice will be considered are marked as 'Yes'.
